NBEA Scholarships to be Awarded

Two \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded this year to NBEA professional members pursuing continuing education or graduate study in business education. The scholarships recognize and support educators who have given evidence of leadership and scholarship potential in the field of business education. The NBEA Scholarship Program provides financial assistance to outstanding individuals for the purpose of continuing their study and professional development in business education. To be eligible for an NBEA scholarship, an applicant must

- Be enrolled in a college or university postbaccalaureate or graduate-level program and submit proof of enrollment.
- Be enrolled in a business education program and/or other related areas in business.
- Submit proof of completion of at least two graduate courses (six semester hours).
- Submit a one-page letter describing (a) past contributions to the field of business education, (b) plans to utilize the degree in the future, (c) two or three significant issues in business education, and (d) why the applicant should receive the award.
- Submit a current resume.
- Submit two letters of recommendation attesting to the scholarship/leadership potential of the applicant.
- Be currently teaching and plan to continue to teach in the field of business education.
- Be a current professional member of NBEA and have been a member for a minimum of one full year prior to submitting an application.

Additional copies of the application form are available from NBEA headquarters. Application forms should be completed and sent to the NBEA office, postmarked no later than December 1, 2015. Previous NBEA scholarship recipients are not eligible to apply.

An anonymous selection committee will evaluate the applications and identify the winners. Scholarship winners must be registered and present at the NBEA awards luncheon on Friday, March 25, NBEA 2016 Annual Convention in Las Vegas, NV, where they will be introduced.

The applicant must submit proof of enrollment; proof of completion of at least two graduate courses (six semester hours); a ONE-PAGE LETTER describing (a) past contributions to the field of business education, (b) plans to utilize the degree in the future, (c) two or three significant issues in business education, and (d) why the applicant should be the recipient of the award; a resume; and two letters of recommendation with this application. PROOF OF ENROLLMENT may be evidenced by a registration form, a letter from the department chairperson, or a letter from the registrar's office. ONE official transcript must be enclosed with the application as proof of course completion (others may be copies). TWO ONE-PAGE LETTERS of recommendation attesting to the scholarship/leadership potential of the applicant must also accompany this application form. Submission of materials other than those requested will render the applicant ineligible.
